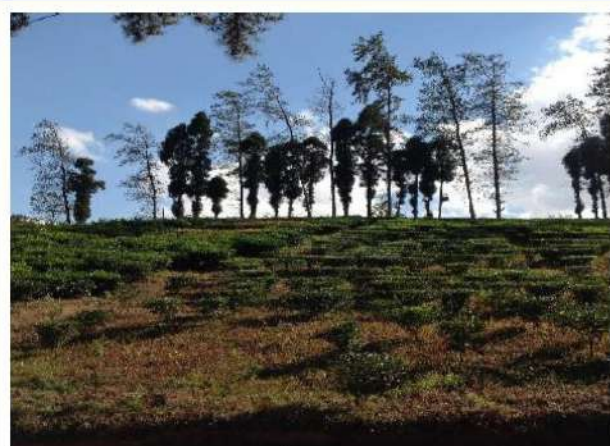

Contributors are requested not to submit papers exceeding 10 printed pages (5000 words). The papers are reviewed by the eminent scholars before accepting for publication. If papers are accepted for publication, contributors will be required to send floppy disks containing the full text of the paper including notes, references, tables, charts, and maps, if any and an amount of Rs. 500 (US Dollar 80 in case of foreign author) towards the processing charges. The manuscripts must be in English. The articles are accepted with an understanding that they are not being submitted for publication elsewhere. The contributors are entitled to receive only one copy of the journal free of cost. The editor reserves the right to publish the articles accepted for publication in the ETDR in a separate edited book simultaneously or afterwards. An author whose paper is accepted for publication has to become life subscribers of the ETDR. In case of failure to these conditions the ETDR reserves the right not to publish papers of such authors.
